Project on urban Reduction of Eutrophication (PURE) highlights concrete local achievements in reducing the nutrient loading to the Baltic Sea, and provides a platform to experience exchange and good practices sharing to motivate new cities and water companies to join the work. Cities, municipalities and water utilities in the Baltic Sea Region are central actors in the implementation of EU or national legislation as well as HELCOM Baltic Sea Action Plan.

The event will showcase the results of PURE project in Belarus, Estonia, Germany, Latvia and Poland; reflect the Polish national situation and also international views on the role of municipal waste water treatment in reaching EU norms and HELCOM recommendations. PURE partner water companies have implemented concrete investments to enhance their phosphorus removal and have planned improvements in their sludge management.
