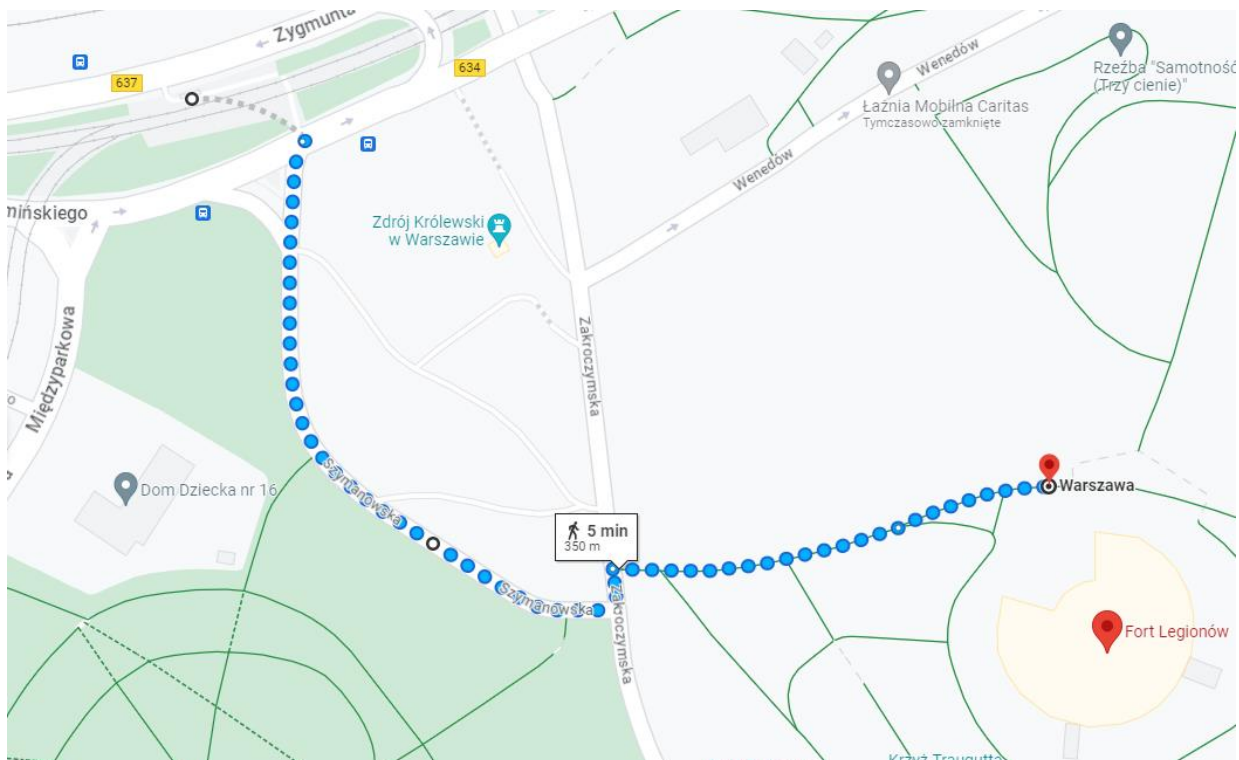
1. Conference date: December 12, 2023, 1:00 PM - 7:30 PM
2. Conference location: Fort Legionów, Zakroczymska Street 12, 00-225 Warsaw
3. Participation in the conference is free of charge (participants cover the costs of travel and any parking and accommodation costs)
4. Applications are sent via an online form. Please send applications by November 24, 2023.

Getting to Fort Legionów:

Public transport – PKP [train] + city transport: considering possible traffic jams (especially in the afternoon) we suggest tram rides:

- From Warszawa Chopin Airport – 3 options:
 - by urban railway (lines S2, S3) to Gdański Railway Station, then by tram to Park Traugutta stop (lines 1, 28) - travel time approx. 50-60 mins; cost PLN 4.40;
 - by bus (line 175) to Centrum stop and by tram then to Traugutta stop (line 18) - travel time approx. 50-60 mins; cost 4.40 PLN;
 - by taxi - travel time approx. 30-40 min; cost PLN 50-70.
- From Warszawa Central Station – 2 options (travel time approx. 30 mins, cost PLN 4.40)
 - 1. by tram to Rondo Radosława stop (lines 17, 33) and by tram then to Park Traugutta stop (lines 1, 28);
 - 2. by tram to Centrum stop (lines 7, 9, 22, 24, 25) and then by tram to Traugutta stop (line 18)
- From Warszawa Gdańska Station - (travel time approx. 16 mins.) by tram to Park Traugutta stop (lines 1, 28)
- From Warszawa Wschodnia Station – (travel time approx. 16 mins.) by tram to Park Traugutta stop (lines 1, 6, 28)

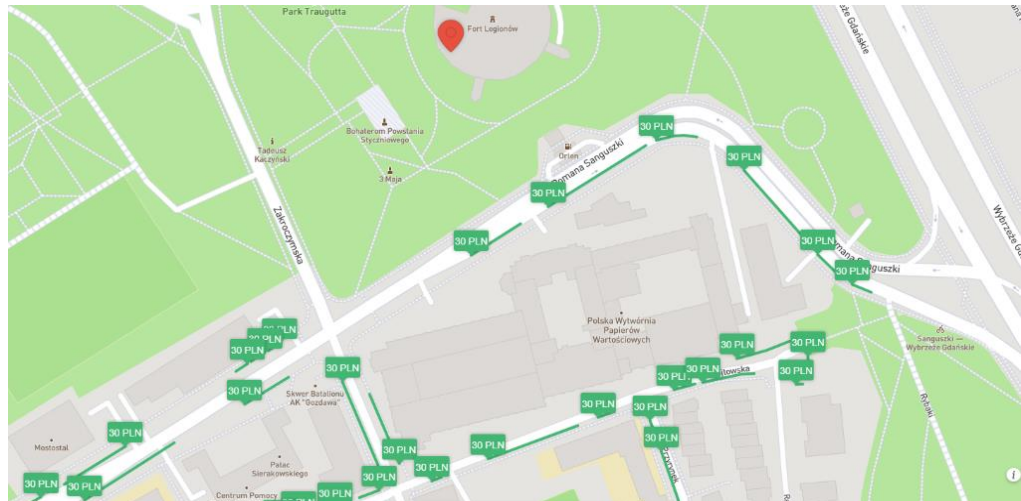
The walk from Park Traugutta stop to Fort Legionów is about 5 minutes (350 m)



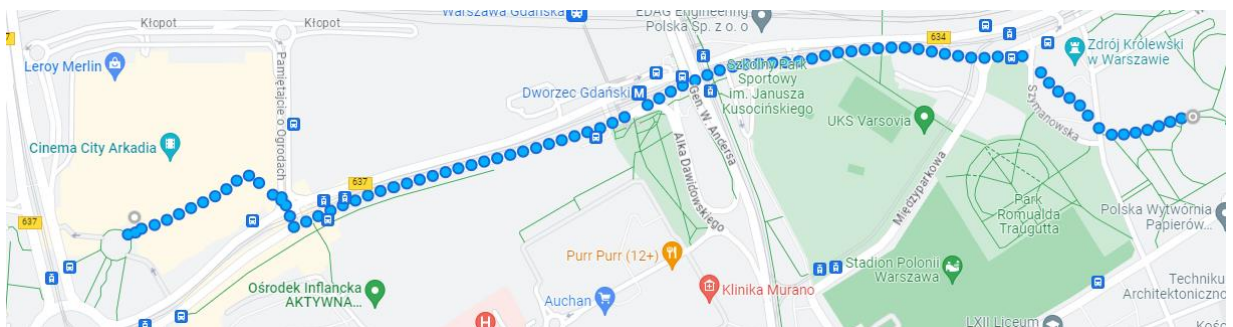
Driving – parking possibilities around Fort Legionów are limited. Please also consider the fact that in the afternoon hours in the city center and this part of the city, traffic jams occur, therefore we recommend you leave your cars at Park and Ride (P+R) car parks near the metro lines or tram lines. To avoid a one-time fee of 100 PLN when using the car parks (P+R), you should purchase a daily ticket entitling you to unlimited travel by public transport in Warsaw (cost PLN 15), showing the daily ticket when leaving exempts you from the aforementioned one-time parking fee (P+R)

- However, if you decide to drive to Fort Legionów, there are the following parking options in the area, in addition to smaller car parks:

- along the streets adjacent to the Fort (parking cost from 1:00 PM to 7:30 PM – PLN 35)

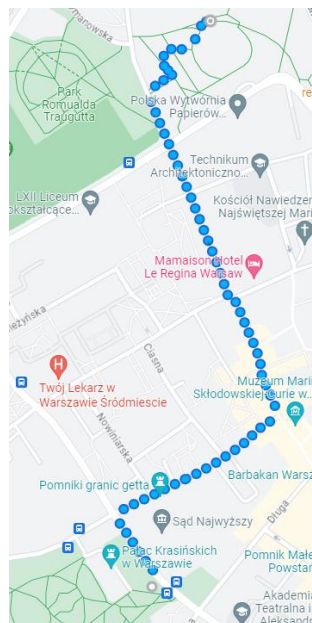


- In [the Arkadia shopping center](#) (free parking) - walk to the Fort (1.5-1.8 km - 22 to 25 min); take



tram lines 1 and 28 to the Park Traugutta stop (ride plus walk to the Fort about 12-15 min).

- In the [underground parking at Plac Krasinskih](#) (price PLN 6 for each started hour or PLN 50 for a day) - walk to the Fort - about 15 min - distance 1.2 km or by bus lines 503, 178 to the Park Traugutta stop (travel time with walk to the Fort about 9 min).
